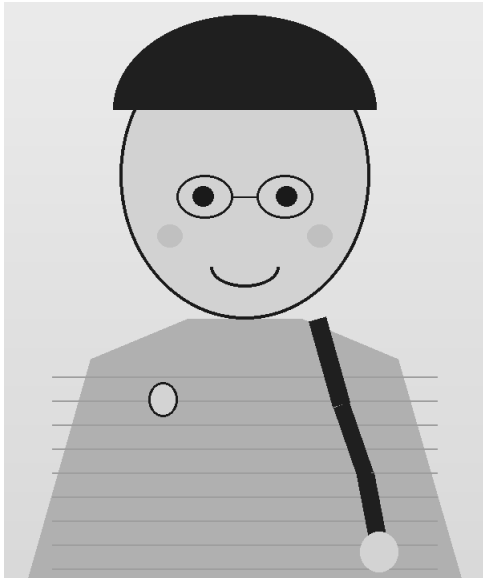

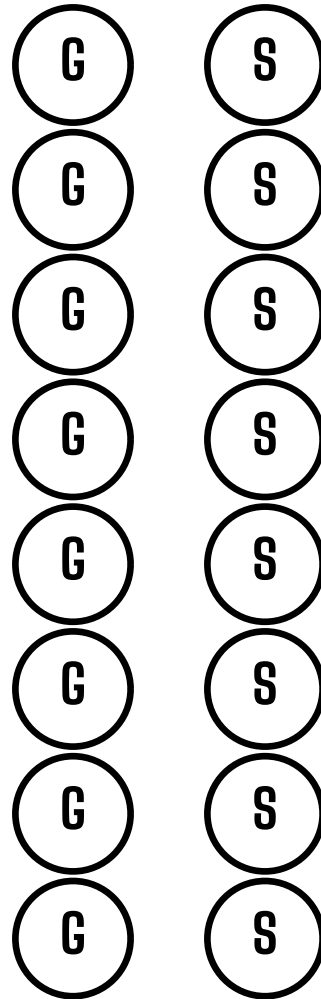
HOLD IT? GOOD. DID IT? SERVICE.

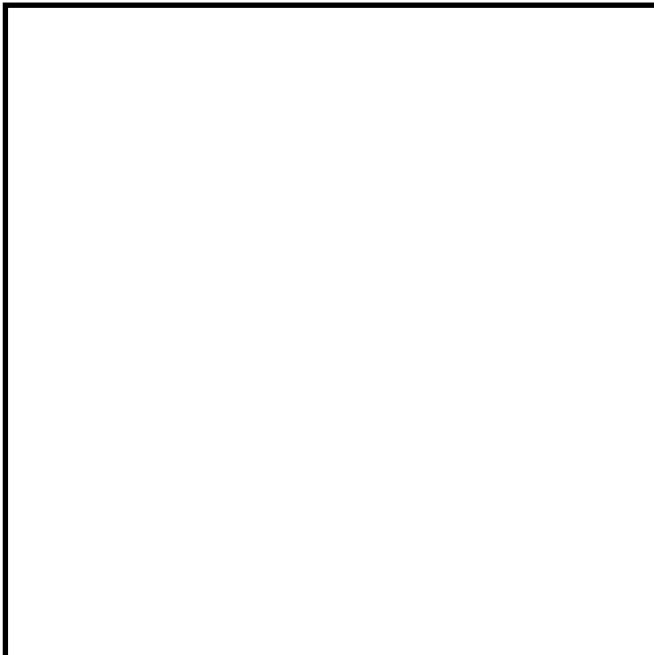
